



Partner-Agency Internship/Fellowship Program

The City of Eagle Pass will partner with private, nonprofit or government entities to form a coordinated city-wide internship/fellowship program. This internship/fellowship program is available for a qualified college student majoring in Business, Communications, Education, Engineering, Healthcare, International Business, Marketing, Political Science, Government or Public Policy from Southwest Texas Junior College or Sul Ross State University, who are at least in their Junior year in college. College graduates will be considered “**fellows**” and undergraduate students will be considered “**interns.**”

The chosen intern/fellow will work with participating business, nonprofit, or government entities in support of the Eagle Pass Business & Economic Development Committee (BEDC) and under the supervision of the partner agency and EMC Strategy Group, LLC. This unique opportunity will expose the intern/fellow to hands real-world professional experience in a business, nonprofit, or government entity in Eagle Pass, TX, and its surrounding community. The intern/fellow will participate in key meetings, such as; site-based staff meetings, the Eagle Pass Business & Economic Development Executive Committee, Sub-Committees, Quarterly Meetings, and Annual Business Meeting.

Interns/fellows will also meet with business and community leaders, elected officials, government employees of city, state, county and federal level.

Typical duties will include communications, research, drafting correspondence, meeting preparation, special event planning, and marketing. Interns will work at least three days a week and coordinate work schedules with the partner agency.

Inter/fellow candidates must apply by submitting applications directly to ernie.gonzalez@emcstrategygroup.com. Candidates must also submit three letters of recommendation from college or university professors and an organizational head from an organization where the candidate volunteers.

Qualifications for internship program:

1. Junior or above from an accredited college or university
2. Major in Business, Communications, Education, Engineering, Healthcare, International Business, Marketing, Political Science, Government or Public Policy
3. Active member in civic or fraternal organization
4. GPA of 2.8 or above
5. Ability to provide own transportation
6. Strong written and oral skills
7. Be personally recommended by a dean, professor or professional mentor

Compensation: The chosen intern/fellow will receive a \$1,200 stipend to be paid equally in three installments during the semester.
